

The Danish Air Force, the Swiss and the French specialist units - are using The Jerven Bag.



The Danish Air Force has placed The Jerven Bag Extreme under all the seats in their Hercules planes, which fly transportation missions to Greenland. This is a variant of the bag called "Rescue", which are thermo bags made in a sharp orange color. The Danish have also placed the Jerven Bag in the seat package in their Fennick A550 helicopters.

French specialty units also have, in addition to the Danish, bought a number of Jerven bags, says Skogheim, and adds, that the Military in other countries have shown interest in The Jerven Bag from Jerven AS as well.

The Jerven Bag in Norwegian F-16 fighter planes?

It is at present being worked on a proposal to make changes to the "seat package", the package, which is placed under the seats of the Norwegian F-16 planes. This seat package contains survival equipment, for use on the ground, after the pilot, in an emergency situation has parachuted. The Norwegian seat packages have remained unchanged for a long time. The packages contain, among other things, a one-person rescue raft and a vacuum packed down sleeping bag. It is the sleeping bag, which

may be exchanged for a model of The Jerven Bag.

It should be stressed, that work is still going on, as to what the seat packages ought to contain, and therefore it will take time, before the final renewal of the packages may be carried out.

However, The Jerven Bag has been used in Norwegian F-16 planes. During the operations in Afghanistan, where Norwegian planes served, The Jerven Bag was a part of the seat package. Latest news is that the swiss army also have started using The Jerven Bag.
